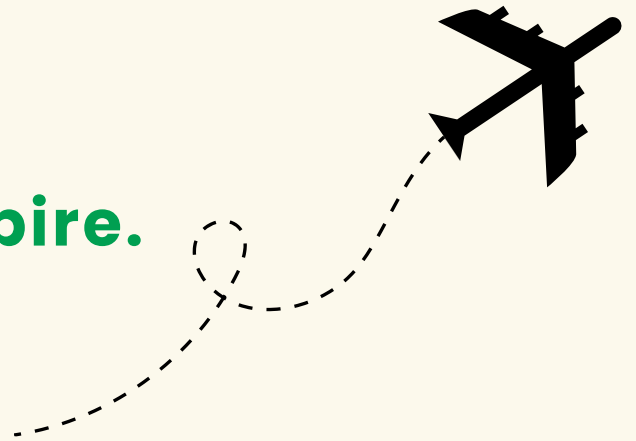

Climate

Sydney boasts four distinct seasons.

Summer runs from December to February and is typically warm to hot with temperatures ranging from 22°C to 30°C.

Autumn runs from March to May ranging from 14°C to 25°C. Sydney's **winter** is June to August when average temperatures drop between 8.8°C-20°C.

In **spring**, which runs from September to November, the days are warmer. Average daily temperatures range from 11°C - 23°C.
