# Getting to Sydney

#### 1. Visas

International visitors need a visa to enter Australia unless they are a citizen of Australia or New Zealand. Find current visa information on the Australian Government website.

# 2. Flights

Sydney Airport is the largest in Australia, with direct flights from 25+ countries. From late 2026, Western Sydney Airport will also operate with 24hr service.

# 3. From the airport

Sydney Airport is only 8km from the Central Business District (CBD), which can be reached by train in under 15 minutes (approx. AUD\$20), and by taxi or rideshare services (approx. 20 minutes, AUD\$45-55).

#### 4. Accomodation

There are more than 44,000 hotel rooms in the city centre, with a range of options, whether you want luxury or affordability, heritage or ultramodern. Find more information

# While you are here

#### 1. Weather

Sydney has a sunny climate year-round, with mild winters and warm summers. Average temperatures:

- Spring (Sept-Nov) 11-23°C (52-73°F)
- Summer (Dec-Feb) 19-26°C (66-78°F)
- Autumn (Mar-May) 15-22°C (58-72°F)
- Winter (Jun-Aug) 9-17°C (48-63°F)

#### 2. Time Zone


The local time zone in Sydney is Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST), which is generally UTC+10. Between October and April, we observe daylight savings and operate on Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT), which is generally UTC+11.

## 3. Local Currency

The Australian currency is the dollar (AUD), which comes in notes (\$5, \$10, \$20, \$50 and \$100) and coins (5, 10, 20 and 50 cents, and \$1 and \$2). Currency exchange services are available at the airport, in the city centre and at most banks and Australia Post offices.

## 4. Getting around

Scenic and compact, Sydney is perfect for walking, with many of the city's venues an easy distance from central hotels. It also has accessible and affordable public transport,



with the option to pay for trips with <u>contactless</u> <u>payment methods</u> or an <u>Opal card</u>. There are also several taxi and rideshare options.

#### 5. Culture life

Sydney is home to a truly diverse population and welcomes people with a range of identities, perspectives and experiences. This makes for a thriving cultural scene, with First Nations <u>arts</u> and <u>cultures</u>; libraries, <u>galleries and museums</u>; <u>live music</u>; and performing arts. #### 6. Food & drink

Sydney might be relaxed, but it is serious about its food and drink. It has a dedicated <u>coffee</u> <u>culture</u>, commitment to brunch, and a range of great <u>bars</u> and <u>restaurants</u> – from the affordable to the flash – with cuisine that spans Asian-fusion, fresh seafood, modern Australian, and European and Middle Eastern cuisine.
